2. Moololo Puuku (Treasure’s Report) 17 ‘Ianuali 2019 (January 17th)

Main Account: \$3,946.45 (statement ending January 31, 2019). No outstanding checks

Ka‘auwai Project Account: \$171,671.13 (statement ending January 31, 2019). Couple outstanding checks remaining

Undetermined if these monies will be extended to this year. Contract expires June 2019. Contract term already extended once.

Need a Board Member to coordinate with OHE Office and KS on the status of extending the Contract term.

Makana for coming will be passed out at the next halawai (we weren’t able to connect with the person who has the merchandise)

5. Next Halawai Topic/Activity

- a. A suggestion was made to move the halawai to 5 Malaki so that we can make lei for La Kupuna. Since we would need to confirm with Leonani to move the date, recommendation to have a separate Lei Making Workshop at the hale aina on 5 Malaki. If Saydee wants to move the March NLK meeting to 5 Malaki and relocate to the Hale Aina, then we can combine the meetings. If not, okay to have a separate event.
Bring your own flowers/ti leaves. NLK will provide people to teach. Will also have some limited lei-making supplies. NLK flier to provide a list of suggested supplies. Request people that if they have extra supplies, bring extra to share. NLK will coordinate getting some extra ti leaves. If we aren't able to move the halawai, then we could still hold a workshop. Lei are needed for the kupuna from the Chinese home. If we have a special event, we need to submit a facility request for the hale aina. If we do a workshop, then start earlier and coordinate with A+ (suggested start time of 3:30 pm to 5:30 pm). **Kelly to prepare a flier.**
