**1. Mo‘olelo Hālāwai (Meeting Minutes)**

**2. Hālāwai (Meeting location and dates)**

### 4. Mo'olelo Kumu

- a. Mo'olelo Po'o Kumu: (Po'o Kumu Baba)
  - Dec 6: Kaimuki Parade
  - New DOE Transportation coordinator. Starting a seating chart to address the crowded buses and discipline on the buses. 3 keiki to a seat is okay for short bus rides, but not for 1.5 hour long. Also working on enforcing bus rules. Will try to seat ohana together where possible, but mostly will seat youngest to the oldest. Will role it out one bus at a time.
  - Secondary school: increase in keiki smoking. Not just e-cigarettes. Additives in the e-cigs (e.g. cannabis). Kula is working on educating the keiki. Require keiki to have parents meet with Poo Kumu to get the e-cigs back. Haven't seen it in the kula ha'a yet. Bus cameras are live. Poo kumu has access to all wikio.
  - Promoting healthy choices. Kula is working with a fitness lifestyle company called "Hele". Increasing education for healthy choices. They are donating equipment to the kula. They will be training with haumana and coaches for strength and conditioning. Will work with makau kino with them, not just

exercise, but also diet and screen time. Would like to do a fitness fair for ohana too.

- b. Mo'olelo Kula Ha'aha'a: (Kumu Kaumuali'i)
  - 10/24 & 10/25: a'ohe kula for parent teacher meetings
  - 10/31: Keiki can wear their lole heleui for the
  - 11/2: K-4 Awards for 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter

**5. GIA Grant Point of Contact**

- a. Have keiki expressed any concerns about the kula: Keiki in kula ha'aha'a concerned about the e-cigs and swearing.
- b. Makua concern: close proximity of haumana kula kiekie to the little ones. Are there other options for additional facilities to provide more separation? Po'o Kumu: kula has actually been working to provide more connectivity. Most incidents have been coming from the bus. Not very many incidents on campus. Acknowledged that they can look for ways to provide supervision for the younger keiki.

d. Regal Fundraiser: successful fundraiser. Many makua really loved the cornflake cookies!
